The 12 tribes of Israel are the descendants of slaves and the indigenous people of the Americas conquered and destroyed. According to the Bible, they are scattered throughout the four corners of the earth. Read Deuteronomy 28:15-68 and II Esdras

Matthew 4:17 "From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." But who did Christ preach to? Only Israelites!

Christ said in Matthew 15:24 "I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel".

John 4:22 "Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews."

Did the preaching of Christ change after his death and resurrection? NO!

Acts 5:31 "Him (Christ) hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins."

Romans 11:26 "And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob."

The children of Israel received the laws and broke them and went into captivity among all nations, they needed a savior. The Prophecies say the scattered Israelites will be gathered from among all nations.

Read **Matthew 28:19,20, Deut. 4:27, Isaiah 11:10-12, Jeremiah 16:14,15, 32:37-41, Hebrews 8:8-13.**

What is Repentance?

Before any Israelite can repent, he or she must acknowledge they've broken the commandments (sins) by confessing them before the Heavenly Father and then keep his Commandments through Christ. **Please read Matthew 19:16-19.**

1 John 3:4 "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the Law: for sin is the transgression of the Law."

Proverbs 28:13: "He that covereth his sins shall not prosper ("covereth" by not admitting to breaking the Commandments): but whoso confesseth (acknowledges that they have committed sin against the LORD, Job 33:27) and forsaketh them (REPENTS of their sins by keeping the Laws and obeying Christ) shall have mercy." also read John 14:21-24.

Psalms 119:9: "Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to thy word." Only by "taking heed" (obedience) to the LAWS of the Most High, can the children of Israel "cleanse" themselves of their sins.

Psalms 19:7: "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple". In keeping the LAWS through Christ, the Israelites must convert (REPENT) their souls from wickedness/sins.

Acts 3:19: "Repent ye therefore, and be converted (keep the Laws), that your sins may be blotted out (forgiven), when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord."

How to Repent

Here are a few verses you can pray in private.

Psalms 51:1-3

1. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy loving kindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

2. Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

3. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me."

Psalms 25:7 "Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD."

Now you must begin to learn and do God's commandments

Psalms 119:165-166

165. Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.
